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



CONCERNING THE LESSONS

The book in your hands is the first in a series called Keys of Understanding Quran. These books are aimed at helping you understand most Quranic sentences without the necessity of a teacher and eleviating the need to spend many hours studying Arabic grammar. It will guide you in reaching the high station of understanding the Holy Quran. From the first of these lessons, the student will become familiar with the result and aim of this series and will taste the sweet worlds of Allah and will take the necessary steps in becoming more aware of the world and true religion. Each lesson being a key which will open thousands of doors of learning Quranic words. All the lessons and exercises deal with Quranic text. The Muslim student needs only to be able to recite Quran and need not be highly educated in Islamic learning. Secondly, after learning 100 lessons, the student would have come to know 95% of the words used in Quran.

Now, it is better we start working and leave the judging to others.





HOW TO WORK

Each time you will receive one book of this series. Read it carefully and do each exercise which you will find are quite easy. Make sure you know it thoroughly before attempting the next book. In spite of the lessons being easy, be very careful. The books should also be treated with respect as they contain verses of Quran.

The statistics given include the words derived from their roots.

Eg. عُلِّم : is the verb meaning to teach

: is the teacher : is Aware, Knower

When translating one of the above words eg. which appears in Quran, you also have to guess the other words derived from its root having the meanings similar to each other and belonging to the same family as in the above example.




